General Membership Meeting with Demo Artist Bob Wantz

Wednesday, November 28th at 7:00 PM

Bob has been a signature member of the Baltimore Watercolor Society for more than twenty-five years; has both an A.B. and a B.S.from Shepherd University and a Masters of Education from McDaniel College. He is primarily a painter of landscapes, who has studied with notable AWS Watercolorists such as; Ray Loos in Cape Ann, Maine, Tom Nicholas in Rockport, Massachusetts, Zoltan Szabo in Warm Springs, Virginia, Murry Wentworth, in Port Clyde, Maine, and at the Edgar Whitney School in Kennebunkport, Maine.

Bob's award-winning watercolors have been exhibited throughout the tristate area, including the WCMFA Cumberland Valley Artists Exhibition, and his work hangs in a variety of local business offices as well as in private collections. A highlight of his painting career was one-man retrospective at the Washington County Museum of fine Arts from Nov. 2002 thru Jan 2003, featuring 30 paintings, representing his thirty years as an outstanding watercolor artist.

In addition to exhibiting his work in Maryland, Virginia, Pennsylvania and West Virginia, Bob has served as a juror for many regional art shows. Bob has been a very popular watercolor instructor for more than twenty years at the Washington County Museum with classes filling up before the current one is even finished. He also teaches at the Hagerstown Community College and has also taught watercolor in the Elderhostel program.
